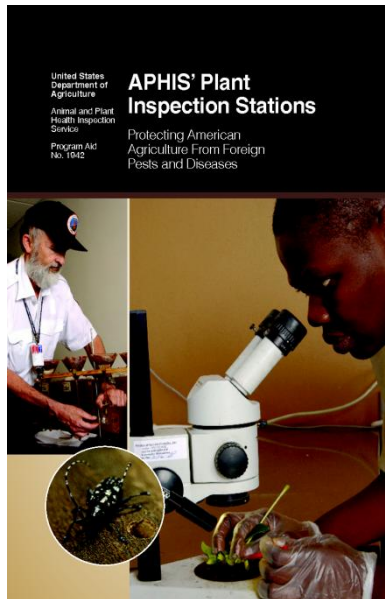

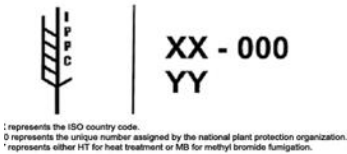

REQUERIMIENTOS DE FOOD & DRUG ADMINISTRATION (FDA)

► **FDA Registration – Registracion Facilidades con FDA:**

Para exportar productos comestibles a los EEUU es necesario registrar la planta empacadora con FDA y tener un Agente en los EEUU

► **FDA Prior Notice (Noticia Anterior) :**

Para carga maritima la transmission debe ser hecha por lo menos 8 horas antes de llegar la carga a EEUU. Carga arribando por avion 4 horas.

► **Detenciones de FDA:**

FDA libera los productos electronicamente. Ellos pueden retener el producto para hacer analisis de pesticida y microorganismos. El primero toma de 2 a 3 dias, el Segundo toma 2 semanas ya que alli los organismos crecen.

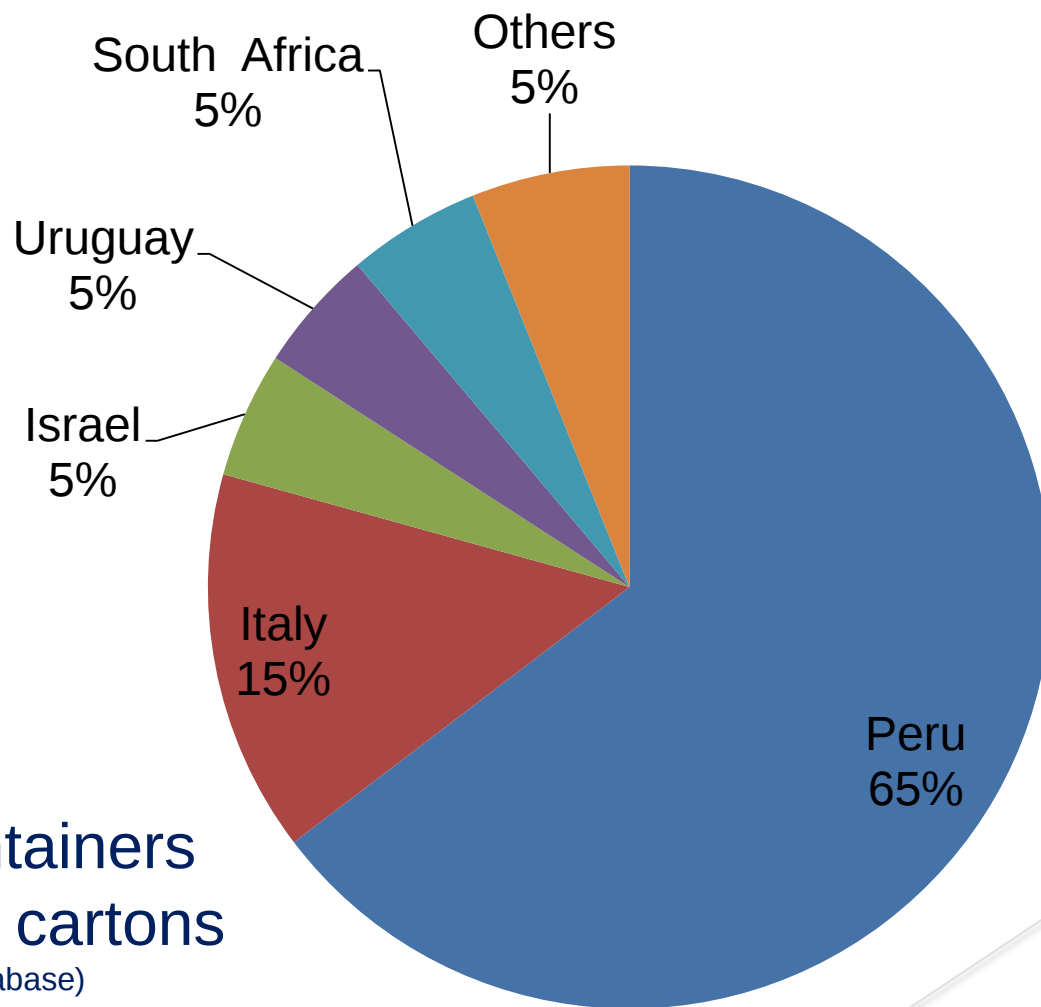

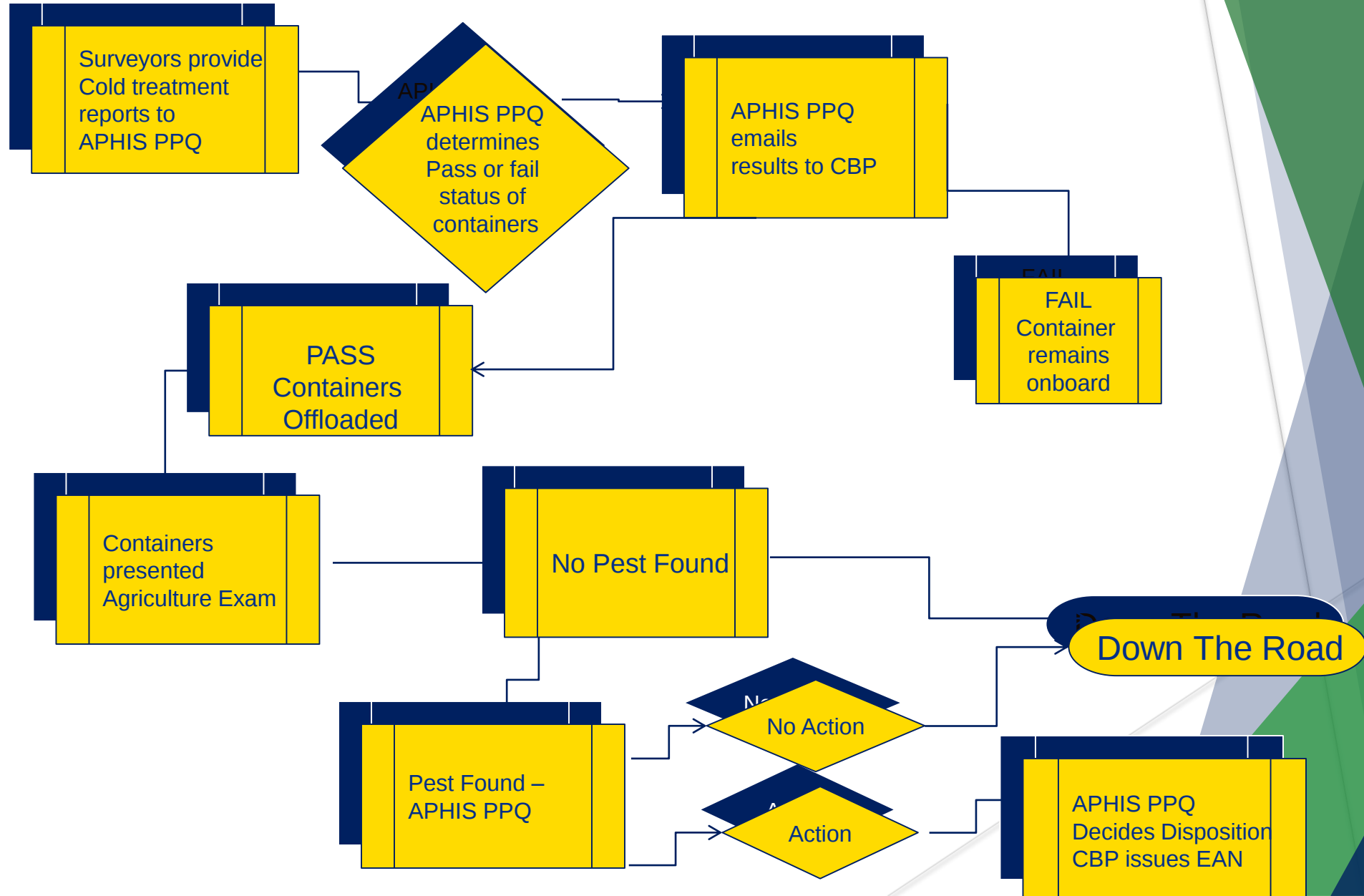


2016 Containerized Cold Treatments-Imports
